

1.3.2 Breakdown of the workforce by age group

Chart 7 provides a breakdown of Canada-based staff by age group and employment category:

- 66.3% of non-rotational employees and 58% of rotational employees are under 50 years of age.
- Non-rotational employees are more numerous in the following age groups: 30-34 years (13.3%), 40-44 years (14%), 45-49 years (15.2%), and 50-54 years (18%). Moreover, the 40 to 54 age group accounts for nearly half (47.2%) of all non-rotational employees.
- Rotational employees are more heavily represented in the following age groups: 35-39 years (14%), 50-54 years (16.9%), and 55-59 years (16.4%). The age groups form two clusters. The first and larger (33.3%) of the two consists of seasoned employees between 50 and 59 years of age. The second (26.8%) consists of those between 30 and 39 years of age.
