The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Howard Green, announced today that the office of the Canadian Government in Brasilia, the new capital of Brazil has now been opened. The office is a branch of the Canadian Embassy which is still located in Rio de Janeiro. The Officer-in-Charge is Mr. D.P. Cole, Second Secretary. Canada is the sixth country to establish an office in Brasilia with a resident officer. Others include the United States, the United Kingdom and France.
