THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS
WELCOMES THE DECLARATION BY THE PRESIDENT
OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA ON RELATIONS
BETWEEN NORTH AND SOUTH KOREA

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, has welcomed the recent declaration made by the President of the Republic of Korea, Roh Tae Woo, which has proposed to improve exchanges between North and South Korea. "We strongly support the restoration of the dialogue between North and South Korea which is critical to easing the tension on the Korean peninsula. I hope that North Korea will respond positively to President Roh's proposals" said Mr. Clark. He recalled that the Korean issue was discussed at the Toronto Summit and considered these proposals as an important contribution to regional stability.
