

must procure a certificate from the returning officer, permitting him to vote in the poll in which he will be stationed on polling day, as provided for by sec. 165.

8th One of the agents of *each candidate* or in absence one of the electors representing each candidate, on being admitted into the poll, will take the oath required by sects. 219, 220, 221.

9th See that the candidate has some one at the door of the poll to give information to friends.

10th Find out if the clerk of the poll has been sworn (sects. 142 and 144). Have the ballot box opened before any ballot paper is put into it, and see that it contains nothing whatever. Then see that the box is at once locked and that remains so during the whole time of voting.

11th See that no one is allowed to enter the poll during the whole time that the voting and counting of the ballots are going on except the deputy returning officer, the clerk of the poll, the candidates and their agents (to the number of two only for each candidate) and in the absence of agents two electors to represent each candidate such electors having requested it, sec. 150.

DURING THE VOTING

12th Insist that the deputy returning officer do not allow more than one elector at a time, to enter the poll, and that he provide a
