

FIG. I.—*ASCARIS MEGALOCEPHALA*.

Length—Male, 6 to 8 inches.

Female, 7 to 18 inches.

FIG. II.—*FILARIA OCULI*, or *F. PAPILLOSA*.

Length—Male, 3 inches.

Female, 7 inches.

(The figure is from a specimen found in the peritoneal cavity. Those located in the eyeball are, as a rule, smaller).

FIG. III.—*OXYURIS CURVULA*, (altered from Law).Length—Male,  $1\frac{3}{4}$  inches.

Female, 4 inches.

FIG. IV.—*STRONGYLUS ARMATUS*.Length—Male,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches.

Female, 2 inches.

FIG. V.—*STRONGYLUS TETRACANTHUS*.Length—Male,  $\frac{1}{4}$  to  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch.Female,  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch.
