FIG. III.—-OXYURIS CURVULA, (altered from Law).

Length—Male, 134 inches. Female, 4 inches.

FIG. IV.—STRONGVLUS ARMATUS. Length—Male, 1 ½ inches. Female, 2 inches.

FIG. V.—STRONGVLUS TETRACANTHUS. Length—Male, $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. Female, $\frac{3}{4}$ inch.
