

In the Long Vacation daily from ten o'clock a. m. until two o'clock p. m.

In the Christmas Vacation daily from ten o'clock a. m. until four o'clock p. m.

- (2.) The Libraries shall be closed on Sunday and on New Year's Day, His Majesty's Birthday, Dominion Day, Christmas Day, Easter Monday, and any other day set apart by public proclamation as a holiday, and in the event of any of the said holidays falling upon a Sunday, the following day; and on Saturday at one o'clock p. m., except when the Courts are sitting.
- (3.) No conversation shall be carried on in the Library.
- (4.) No person shall place his hat, great coat, cloak, etc., on any table or chair in the Library.
- (5.) No book shall be taken out of the building in which the Library is situated.
- (6.) It shall be the duty of the Assistant Librarians to report to the Secretary any infringement of the rules or orders of the Society for the regulation of the Libraries.
- (7.) The Judges of the Supreme and County Courts shall be at liberty to take books from the Library, upon application to the Librarian or Assistant Librarian, and any member of the Law Society in good standing requiring the use of any book upon the argument of a case in the building in which the Library is situated shall be at liberty to have such book upon application to the Librarian or Assistant Librarians, such book to be returned to its place in the Library within a reasonable time after the close of the argument for which it may have been required.
- (8.) For the application to the Librarian or Assistant Librarian mentioned in the last sub-section, it shall be sufficient to enter the name and volume of the book required and of the person taking the same in a register book, one of which shall be kept in each of the Libraries for that purpose.
- (9.) If any member of the Society or other person entitled to use the Library shall fail to observe the regulations relating to the Libraries, any two of the Discipline Committee may deprive such offending member of the use of any of the Libraries for such time as they may deem proper, and the names of any suspended members shall be posted in the Libraries.
