The temperance movement in Canada has hitherto been deficient in the department of LITERATURE. This want has long been sorely felt by all workers in this field of labor; and to meet it this enterprise was first undertaken. Its objects are:

1. The publication of THE CANADA CITIZEN, a first-class weekly family journal devoted to the advocacy and assistance of all branches of the Temperance reform.

2. The establishment and maintenance of a

TEMPERANCE PUBLICATION HOUSE,

for the supply of Campaign Sheets, Pamphlets, Tracts, Leaflets, Reports, Mottoes, Pledge Cards, and other forms of literature and printed matter for aiding the temperance cause, or properly equipping societies and workers.

The present authorized capital stock is \$10,000, divided into 1,000 shares of \$10 each, payable ten per cent. on allotment, and five per cent. per month afterwards. Power can be obtained to increase the capital stock when the Company's undertakings demand it.

This institution is intended to be in the interests of all societies and movements having for their objects moral reform and social advancement. For this reason it has among its shareholders and directors prominent and representative persons of the various organizations, some of which are—Church Temperance Societies, the Dominion Alliance with its affiliated
