DR. JAS. CHRISTIE DIES IN BOSTON, 96 YEARS OLD

Was Prominent Here and Helped to Establish General Public Hospital

DR. JAMES CHRISTIE, who for nearly half a century was a prominent and popular physician, known to every resident of Saint John, and who was associated in the founding of the General Public Hospital here, died at the Phillips House, Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston, Friday, Sept. 10, 1926, aged 96 years. Word of his death was received in the city last night.

Many here will remember Dr. Christie as a kindly, genial physician. The doctor was the eldest of the three doctors Christie who were practicing their profession in this city at one time, all members of one family, and while each of the three was a leader in his profession and each

skilled surgeon, Dr. James ranked prominently. He was a son of the late William and Anne Christie and was born at Nerepis. His medical training was obtained at a medical school in Philadelphia and shortly after his graduation the United States was in the grip of the Civil War.

SURGEON IN CIVIL WAR

Dr. James Christie served as an army surgeon throughout the conflict and then returned to New Brunswick to practice his profession. He located in Saint John and he was soon acknowledged as the ablest surgeon of this city at that time. He assisted and supported Dr. William Bayard in his pioneer work in establishing the General Public Hospital in Saint John and throughout his long years of life in this city he retained a very keen interest in the welfare of that institution. Up to about 10 years ago he was serving as a member of the Board of Commissioners.

HELD HIGH OFFICE.

Dr. James Christie had held the highest offices his associates—in the profession could bestow. He was president of the New Brunswick Medical Society, president of the Saint John Medical Society and a member of the Medical Council of New Brunswick. He was most hospitable and loved about the city in his doctor's carriage he was a striking figure of very handsome appearance. It was only half a dozen years ago that he left Saint John to reside with his daughter, Mrs. K. N. Bostwick, at Brookline, Mass. In his United States home he still retained a lively interest in all the doings of his native province and the city of Saint John and when New Brunswickers visited him he was eager to know of all the changes and happenings here. He was remarkably active and retained his faculties unimpaired.

ACTIVE IN COMMUNITY.

His younger brother, Dr. William Christie, studied medicine in his office and was closely associated with him. Dr. William Christie practiced in the north end of the city and was also one of the leading surgeons of the city and also served as alderman. A third brother was Alexander Christie, of the Christie Woodworking Company, Saint John, and his son, Dr. William A. Christie, was also a very able surgeon. Dr. William A. Christie died only a few years ago.
