How Buffalo Finds Work For Soldiers. Pays \$12 a Week to Those Who Lack Work, But Only Eight on Roll.

Buffalo, May 16—Federal officials who have been studying the operation of bureaus engaged in the task of placing returned soldiers in employment are considering the advisability of a country wide adoption of the Buffalo method.

Buffalo provides jobs for soldiers and pays those not employed and in need \$12 a week from the city treasury. But the employment office has worked so well that Finance Commissioner Heald, who distributes the allowances, has on his rolls only eight men from among 16,000 soldiers returned to civil life.

The Buffalo committee is headed by Herbert E. Crooch, a business man, and is composed of men who employ mechanical and clerical help. It handles soldiers, sailors and marines exclusively in the matter of employment. It has the co-operation of the state employment bureau and agents of the Red Cross, Knights of Columbus, Jewish Welfare and other organizations work in conjunction with this bureau.

Soldiers are listed for employment immediately upon landing from overseas or immediately upon their return to the city in casual contingents. By a system of canvassing former employers fully

fifty per cent of the returning men are placed in jobs they quit to enter the service. By the co-operation of 4,000 or more employers others are readily placed. Soldiers have been found eager to go to work and employers have not lost by engaging them.

The allowance fund of \$12 a week for soldiers who could not secure positions was established two months ago by the city council on suggestion of the finance commissioner. At the end of two months he reported that eight men were on the rolls because of incapacity to work, not because of unwillingness. Others had been placed through the citizens' employment bureau. Not a soldier was in want.


