Opening of a Remarkable Railway in London.

The London papers announce further extension of rapid transit in that city by the completion and opening for public traffic, on April 5, of the East London Railway, which is another of those gigantic underground enterprises for which the metropolis of England is so distinguished. The most remarkable feature of this new work is the fact that a considerable portion of the line is built under the city. The center of the world may be said to float and invagate directly over a part of the roof of the tunnel, which extends south easterly, from the Liverpool street station of the Great Eastern Railway, passing
