## DESCENDING "DEEPEST DIP" On scenic railway, cars crash at terrific speed.

Every one of the thirty-two passengers injured.

**NEW YORK, July 7.**—Every one of the thirty-two passengers and two operators on two scenic railway trains in Palisades Park, above the Port Lee Landing, crashed at terrific speed into another filled with two cars which had become stalled at the base of the "deepest dip." The four cars were so crushed into one another that they had to be chopped up piece by piece to get the injured, among whom there were as many women as men.

**On the roller coaster, which is known as one of the largest in the world, there are two dips in the rails where the descent is so steep that it is almost perpendicular.**

**After taking the first dip, which is a fall of sixty feet, the train of two cars, in a charge of an operator, shoots past way up an incline. When its momentum has almost spent it has a gear which fits into a steel chain that holds it at the crest of the way of the incline. Then, after turning a sharp corner, the cars descend the "deepest dip," which is down fifty feet and so nearly perpendicular that it is almost vertical.**

**Up the incline the cars remain on the rails. When the first train of two cars, in a charge of an operator, shoots past way up an incline, the second dip like a ball of lead. Up the next incline the cars speed, and just as the top of a woman shouted that she had lost her hat. The operator almost involuntarily moved his lever.
