GEMS OF ROLLED OATS.—Soak two cups of rolled oats for five hours (or over night) in one and three-quarter cups of four milk. Add one teaspoonful (sevel) of soda, one teaspoontul of sait, one-half teacupful of light brown sugar, one teacupful of sifted flour, and two well-beaten eggs, in the order given, the soid alisolved in a little water. Bake in hot, well-greased gern pans, in a hot over, for twenty-five minutes. Delicious with tresh fruit.

Dainyt Corn Meal Muyens.—Beat together, in order mentioned, two eggs, two tablespoonfuls of white sugar, one and a half cups sweet milk, a half teaspoonful of sait, a cupful of Indian-meal (white preferred), two outpuls of flour sifted with two heaping teaspoonful of melted butter. Bake in hot gem-pansfor twenty minutes, in hot oven. Delicious. Water may be used instead of milk. Those left over may be heated by steaming, or may be used for the foundating:— Indian Sponge Pudding.—Crumble cold
