Union Government Shows In-comparable Legislative Pro-gramme for Term of Office -Stick to N. P .- Mr. Bourassa Takes Note of Pres.

Liberal Paper on Borden.
(London Free Press.)
The Brantford Expositor, a vigorous Liberal newspaper, says Sir Robert Borden's retirement would be "distinctly regrettable," and doubts "whether a leader can be found of sufficient strength, personal magnetism, and prestige, to hold the Government together, and prevent it from dritting back into the chaos of party strife." The Expositor reviews "the services rendered by the premier to Canada during the greatest crisis in the history of the country," and traces directly to the consciptive measure enforced by the Borden government and the provision of adequate reinforcements "the brilliant record of the Canadian troops during the last hundred days of the, war." The Expositor says: "This does not constitute the chief record of the Union Government under Sir Robert Borden," and it makes this emphatic statement: "There is no government in Canada, during anything like a similar length of time, that can show a program of legislation comparable to that of the Union Government."

Assuredly there could be no "infirmity of purpose" in the leader of a government that has outclassed all previous administrations in the number and importance of the public measures to which it has given effect.
