last year there have been several India is of the Mohawk tribe converted through the instrumental ty of one of the mem bers of the Parent Society; and who have associated themselves with the Methodist Episcopal Church. We, also, learn that others of this tribe have joined with them; so that in all seventy nine have thrown themselves upon this Society, by joining the Church, and are looking that it will provide for them a spiritual teacher: one who can go out, and in before them, and break to them the bread of life.

Others, also, of the same tribe, it is fully beleived, will follow the example of their brethren; and avail themselves of the ministry of our Church. These indians in their presen condition, we think, require the assistance of this Society; is the support of a Missionary among them.

The Board have learned, also, that there are destitute set tlements, in different sections of the Province, who are look ing to this Society for it to provide spiritual teachers for them; and that in order to a greater extension of the work God, these settlements actually require assistance from the society.

The Board has alluded to these facts, not with a view dictating to this Society any mode of procedure; but in ordto bring the subject before it.

There are, now, in the Parent Society, including the off cers, twenty six members. The amount received from t Parent Society is $\pounds 5$ 0s, C'y. There is now due $\pounds 1$ 1 Currency.
