Sabbath Services, morning at 11 a. m. ; evening at 7 p. m. Sabbath School at 3 p. m. ; quarterly service for the young at 3 p. m. on the last Sabbath of March, June, September and December.

The Regular Meetings of the Sabbath School Association are held on the last Thursday of each month.

The Ladies' Association meets every Thursday at 2.30 p. m.

The Ordinance of Baptism is dispensed on the first Sabbath of every month, at the commencement of the morning service, and on the first Wednesday of every month at the commencement of the prayer meeting.

The Ordinance of the Lord's Supper is dispensed on the last Sabbath of March, June, September and December.

A Preparatory Service on the Friday immediately preceding each of the said Sabbaths at 7.30 p. m.

Special Collections for the poor are taken up on the FRIDAY EVENING and SABBATH MORNING, on every Sacramental occasion, separate from, and unconnected with the envelope system.

The Annual Meeting of the congregation is held on the third Wednesday of January.

Members and Adherents leaving the church are requested to give notice to the managers, in order that their seats may again be allocated.

When members change their residence they should give notice either to the Pastor or the Elder of the District, otherwise they cannot reasonably expect to be visited or have their communion cards delivered.
