IV. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons travening this shall chase, hunt, take or kill, or shall assist in or encourage any chasing, hunting, taking or killing any Deer, Fawn, Moose, or Elk with hounds of any breed or sort within this Province, or shall allow any hound of any kind 5 or sort, belonging to him or them, or in his or their possession, or under his or their control, to be used for such purpose, or to follow such chase of its own accord, or unaccompanied by any person, at any time of the year, except during the period between the first of September and the 10 fifteenth of November in each year, or shall take or kill any wild Duck, Teal, Widgeon or other aquatic birds at any other season of the year than between the first day of July and the first day of May, (inclusive) in each and every year, or shall kill any Woodcock at any other time 15 than between the first day of July and the first day of January, (inclusive) in each year, or shall take or kill any speckled Trout at any other time than between the first day of April and the first day of August, such person or persons shall for every offence be liable to the pains 20 and penalties imposed upon persons by the Statute of the Province of Upper Canada, passed in the second year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to " amend an Act passed in the fourth year of the Reign of "His late Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled, 25 " 'An Act for the preservation of Deer within this Pro-" ' vince, and to extend the provisions of the same, and to " ' prohibit hunting and shooting on the Lord's day,'" who are guilty of offending against the provisions of the said Act, and the person or persons offending against this Act 30 shall be prosecuted, and the penalties and pains shall be enforced in the same form and by the same means and in the same manner as are prescribed with regard to offenders under the said Act.
