Any person who is the sole head of a family or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by ather, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties-Six months' residence upon and cultivaton of the land in each of three years. A home-steader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely cwned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pie-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the homestead of pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.






