Without considering the fact of Moore's name appearing in the application jointly with Henney, the undersigned thinks that as he (Moore) in his letter and affidavit distinctly claims to have been the original discoverer, and as it was established at the investigation held by Mr. Webb that Henney was the original discoverer, which fact is further substantiated by the letters forwarded by Mr. Webb as well as by the persons referred to by Moore to support his claim, the evidence now before the Dept. is sufficient to justify it in allowing Henney's claim as the person entitled to purchase the location as the original discoverer.
