In 1889 Mr. Surveyor Ponton surveyed Reserve 105 for the Montreal Lake Send which according to the Pay sheets of that year numbered IOI scale, this outiling them to 50.5 square miles under the stipulations of freaty No. 5. Reserve 106 sontains \$8 50. Miles this giving Montreal Lake Band more land than it was entitled to according to the population of 1880.
