Re: Alberta Natural Resources.

I attach hereto telegrams from Premier Greenfield of Alberta and the Honourable C. R. Mitchell, Leader of the Opposition, regarding permission to table correspondence relative to Natural Resources negotiations.

Since Premier Greenfield's letter of Dec. 16, 1924, there is a further letter from him dated January 23rd, 1925, taking note of the fact that Col. Biggar has the matter in hand and asking particulars as to how his work ~~was~~<sup>is</sup> proceeding and at what date an answer might reasonably be expected.
