7. <u>Group 4</u> will exercise the important and essential functions of control and co-ordination over the rest of the Ministry (e.g., in the direction of checking over-production or over-expenditure) in the following ways:

- 3 -

- (i) qualitative finance, under the Deputy Director-General;
- (ii) through the Director of Co-ordination who will watch over and co-ordinate Groups 2 and 3 in particular. He will receive extensive progress reports from them, make suggestions if necessary to secure economical production and use publicity measures and generally preside at any meetings between them in order to plan programmes in the most economical manner;
- (iii) through the Director of Intelligence who will be responsible for the collection and collation of information on all matters of interest to the Information Ministry and particularly of reports respecting the effect of the Ministry's public activities and how far these appear to be justified by the results achieved.
