Dec.2/42	<u>Enemy aliens</u> - recommendation re revocation of naturalization approved	S.S.	Communication sent to the Commissioner of Internment Operations for a list of the names of British subjects interned. When this list has been received, it will be checked with the naturalization records and the R.C.M.P. will be asked to make a report from their files in each case (8/12/42) (See further S.S.schedule)
Dec.9/42	<u>Prisoners of war - further transfer</u> - communication to U.K. approved.	E.A.	Telegram No.2383 of 23/12/42 to H.C.London, stating that 8,000 prisoners will be accepted, but that no further commitment has been made for 1943, and asking H.C. to inform U.K. authorities accordingly.
Dec.9/42	<u>Transport overseas of Service personnel</u> - recommendation approved.	N.D.	Chief of General Staff, Adjutant-General, Quartermaster General and Military Secretary advised accordingly.
Dec.9/42	<u>Representations of Roman Catholic Archbishops</u> - reply re Sunday observance and employment of women.	N.D.	Military Secretary now preparing letters for Defence Ministers. Memo Adjutant General Dec. 24/42 used in preparation reply by J.W.P. and sent to Prime Minister for approval Jan.12/43 (Prime Minister's files and Defence Council submission Jan.9/43). Draft reply approved C.W.C. Jan.21/43 - letter Prime Minister to Cardinal Villeneuve Jan.22/43.
