 would be by purchase.
 If the families are settled
 upon different lots and
 have made improvements
 thereon, and these lots have
 not been otherwise disposed
 of by the Crown Lands Dept.
 at Quebec, I presume they
 would have little or no
 difficulty in purchasing
 them; and this Department
 might come to their aid
 in laying their instalments
 upon the land. Crown Lands
 generally in the Province
 of Quebec are sold at the
 rate of 25 cents per acre.
