
OTTAWA, 16th February, 1906.

Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 12th instant, inclosing a communication from John Abins, Chief, and Louis Bebonang requesting information concerning the application of a man for a white oak log 43 feet 28 X 12, and in reply to inform you that a Permit may be issued to the Chief and Associate to cut and sell the stick as soon as the consent of the Band shall have been maintained and provided the price is made satisfactory in addition to dues of \$15.00 per M.C. ft.

Such a stick should sell for about forty cents a cubic foot at the Reserve and be paid for in full before removal.
