

Sir,-

I have your letter of the 12th with regard to Soldier Settlement. I may say that copy of the instructions have been sent to the Indian Agent and you should apply to him for any information which you desire.

I may state however, that land forming part of an Indian Reserve which is sold to a returned Indian soldier would not be held by him in fee simple, but rather under Location Ticket. If land were secured outside a reserve, however, there is no reason why titles should not be given to the purchaser when he has completed his payments.
