- A 1944.
- Q Have you received any further medical treatment since that time ?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q Where ?
- As In Dauphin.
- Q By whom?
- A Dr. Bottomley.
- Q Now at 0800 hours on the 10th day of June, 1943, where were you?
- A I was in Camp Borden Hospital, Sir.
- Q What were you in Camp Borden Military Hospital for ?
- A For stomach trouble.
- Q How long had you been in the hospital?
- A About a couple of weeks I think, Sir.
- Q And what treatment did you get ?
- A Well, I had X-rays and stomach treatments, Sir.
- Q Do you know what medical category you were at that time ?
- A So far as I knew, Sir, I was "E".
- Q Category "D" ?
- A That is right, Sir.
- Q Now at 0800 hours, the 10th of June, 1943, you left Camp Borden Military Hospital?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q So far as you knew where was your kit at that time ?
- A In the Detention Barracks at Camp Borden.
- Q Was your complete kit there ?
- A All with the exception of my battle dress and boots, one pair of socks.
- Q Where were they ?
- A In the Pack Stores of the hospital.
- Q In the Pack Stores of Camp Borden Military Hospital ?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q Now you left without leave at that time did you not ?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q Why?
- A So far as I knew they were going to return me to the detention quarters and put me back in detention.
