

Reference your file No 571A. July 28th 1915.

I have the honor to submit the following recommendations
and remarks regarding applications for new lands which I am
taking ad seriatim and band by band.

QUATSINO BAND. KOSKEMO BAND.

It is noted that of the fifteen applications made by this
band that apparently the only one which is possibly available
is the small island in Quatsino Narrows close to KULTAH RESERVE.

In application No 9 which I am asked to report upon I find
that it Crown granted being portion of Section 16 Township
4 Rupert Land District. In comparing two blue prints there is
a difference in the lines one shewing the application to be
in Sec 15 and the other in Sec 16.

I am not in a position to state whether application No
II should be submitted as an alternative recommendation as I
am not sure of the exact location it not being marked on my
map.
