

ENTRANCE TO WESTMINSTER SCHOOL—LONDON.

HERE, the Rev. Samuel Wesley was for many years one of the Ushers, and here he prepared his brother Charles to become a student at Christ's Church, Oxford. Charles Wesley left Westminster for Oxford in his twentieth year, 1726, and Samuel became head master at Tiverton School in 1732. He had been in office as a Tutor there for nearly twenty years, and near that place resided his grandmother, the widow of the Rev. John Wesley, of Winterbourne-Whitechurch.
