The Society was formed in December, 1895. The annual meeting is held on Oct., 13th. Since May, 1896, over six thousand articles have been gathered in the Historical Room—thirty-seven pamphlets have been published, eleven historical sites have been marked, an historical building erected at a cost of over \$6,000, and a catalogue published.
