A Red Flag	denotes a vessel from	Europe
A White Flag	do do	Newfoundland
A Blue Flag	do do	West-Indies
A Red Pendant	do do	United States
A white pendant	do do	A Coaster
A Blue pendant	do do	From some part of the world for which there is no particular signal.

A white pendant over any of the above, denotes a vessel to have failed, either before, or at the same time, with the one already arrived.

Repeats, from Out-Posts, at Fort George.

For a square rigged vessel—two balls of a size

A Ship—a large ball at the end of the yard, with a small ball in the centre

A Brig—a small ball at the end of the yard, with a large ball in the centre
