A STRAIN OF HEAVY MILKERS

THE blood of Daisy Pauline Pletziro appeared early carried with it the ability to make big records. Daisy was bred and raised by Mr. R. H. Hagerman, of Harold, Ont. In one year, she made 33,667 lbs. milk and over 1,800 lbs. butter. Her seven-day record was 28.29 lbs. butter and 74 lbs. milk, with 110 lbs. as her highest day.

Recently, Mr. Hagerman has been tested two half sisters to Daisy. A three-year-old, Helena Pletziro Plus, produced 33 lbs. milk in one day and 659 lbs. in 14 days. Each cow has a record being 5.43 lbs. A five-year-old, Helena Pauline Pletziro, gave 37.5 lbs. milk in one day and 37.5 lbs. in seven days. Daisy Pletziro Korndyke, a four-year-old daughter of Daisy Pauline Pletziro, gave 32.9 lbs. in one day and 32.9 lbs. in one day. This is surely a great tribute to the value of the blood behind these heifers. The family is one of the best producers in the Dominion.

THE BREED OF CHAMPIONS

EDITOR, Farm and Dairy.-It is unfortunate that misstatements such as are credited to E. A. Grombacher in Farm and Dairy on the subject of the Jersey cow should be made. Each breed has its own special attractions and each is a field of usefulness to fulfil peculiar to its own breed. No one should have any objection to the Jersey sirelings having their cows excel the production of other breeds, or to the Jersey cow in bred companions one should be careful that its statements are true, especially if it is made in such a reliable forum as Farm and Dairy. To state that the Jersey sold four records over the Kenmore is not correct. Assuming that Mr. Grombacher knows whereof he speaks, and the record of Jersey cows correctly given then the Jersey sold two out of the five classes, the other two being the Holsteins five, and this considering that the seven and 30-day records are the popular Holstein records, being very much more accurate, is surely proof enough of the Holstein superiority in the dairy cow.
