So it paffed in the negative and thereupon,

Ordered, That Mr. Wallace, Mr. Hartshorne, Mr. Schwartz, Mr. Hart and Mr. Millidge, be a Committee accordingly, and that the Clerk do acquaint the Council therewith.

Refolved, That this Houfe will on Sunday next, attend Divine Service, at St. PAUL'S Church, and that Mr. Speaker, do acquaint the Right Reverend Father in God, the Bifhop of *Nova-Scotia*, with the fame.

Then the House adjourned, till To-Morrow at Ten of the Clock.
