Of *Isaac Humphrey Culp*, of the Township of *Stamford*, in the District of *Niagara*; praying for the payment of a claim held by the late *Robert Randall*, for expenses incurred while representing a large portion of the Inhabitants of *Upper Canada* in *England* in the year 1827.

Of *H. B. Smith* and others; praying for an Act of Incorporation to enable them to construct a Railroad from *Carillon* to *Grenville*.

Of *John Egan*, Esquire, and others, Merchants, Lumberers, and others engaged in the Timber Trade on the *Ottawa* River and its tributaries; praying that the duties on certain articles used in the Lumber Trade may be remitted, so far as regards the said Trade.

Of *James Motz*, of the City of *Quebec*, Esquire, Advocate; praying to be relieved from the necessity of proving the Act by which he holds the Toll Bridge over the River *Etchemin*—and to be secured in the enjoyment of his said Bridge, and the Tolls arising therefrom.

Of *John Clark*, of the Parish of *Longue Pointe*, Esquire; praying that he may be enabled to recover the amount due him by the Trustees of the *Montreal* Turnpike Roads, for ground taken from him and damages suffered under the Ordinance 3 *Victoria*, chap. 31.

Of the *Quebec* Bank; praying for an increase of its capital stock, and for certain amendments to its charter.

Of *Nicolas Benjamin Doucet*, of the City of *Montreal*, Esquire, Notary Public; praying for aid in consideration of the utility and labour of a work compiled by him, called "Fundamental Principles of the Laws of *Canada*."
