Whelan Hon. Edward; absent at the call of the House, 81; appears and is excused, 81.

— Retires without the bar. on motion that the House do resolve itself into a Committee of Privileges to consider a certain article published in the Examiner, 96; debate on motion to go into Committee, 98; his letter of apology for said article communicated by Mr. Speaker, *ib.*; question on motion to go into Committee of privileges, proposed, *ib.*; motion of amendment that the apology offered in Mr. Whelan's letter be accepted, 99; Mr. Speaker declined receiving the motion of amendment, as unparliamentary at this stage, stating the proper course to be for the House to resume itself into a Committee of privileges, *ib.*; House in Committee, and Mr. Whelan's letter referred, *ib.*; further considered, 100; and resolution reported declaring him guilty of a high contempt and breach of the privileges of the House, and that he be reprimanded by Mr.

Speaker, and apologize to the House for the said contempt, *ib.*; he retires without the bar, *ib.*; motion to amend report negatived on division, *ib.*; report adopted, 101; he appears at the bar in custody and is reprimanded by Mr. Speaker, *ib.*; addresses Mr. Speaker and offers apology, *ib.*; Mr. Speaker declines receiving apology as offered, as not being in accordance with resolution of the House, *ib.*; motion that he be withdrawn, *ib.*; motion of amendment that his apology be accepted negatived on division, *ib.*; he is withdrawn, *ib.*; motion that the House do adjourn negatived, 102; further considered and resolution reported dictating apology, *ib.*; he is produced at the bar in custody and apologises in terms of resolution of the House, *ib.*; is ordered to be discharged on payment of fees, *ib.*
