THE ENGLISH COLONIZATION SCHEME.

Farms to be Let to Tenants. The Scheme Regarded Favorably by Business Men.

London, Dec. 12.—Tomorrow the prospectus of the new land company to promote the colonization of lands in the North West will be issued. The title of the Company has been changed to "The Land Corporation of Canada." The capital is fixed at £500,000, divided into fifty thousand shares of £10 each. The directors are the Duke of Manchester, Robert G. Allan, Sir Rowland Blomfield, Messrs. Alexander Fraser, Ellis Gilman, Arthur Grennell, Henry Maynard. There will be a Canadian local committee consisting of Messrs. Bannatyne, Bain, Blainford, and others, of Winnipeg. The bankers in London will be the Westminster Bank, and in Canada the Bank of Montreal. The corporation has the option of purchasing from the syndicate one million acres of land along the main line of the Canada Pacific Railway or its branches. They contemplate also purchasing other lands from the Hudson Bay Company and the Government of Canada. They will divide the land into farms of from 600 acres each to 500 acres each. On each farm they will erect suitable buildings and will let these farms to tenants. The terms will be very easy with a view to invite settlement. The tenants will be offered the option of purchasing their farms on certain conditions. The project is received generally with favor among the business men in the city, and it is thought the shares will be disposed of without difficulty.
