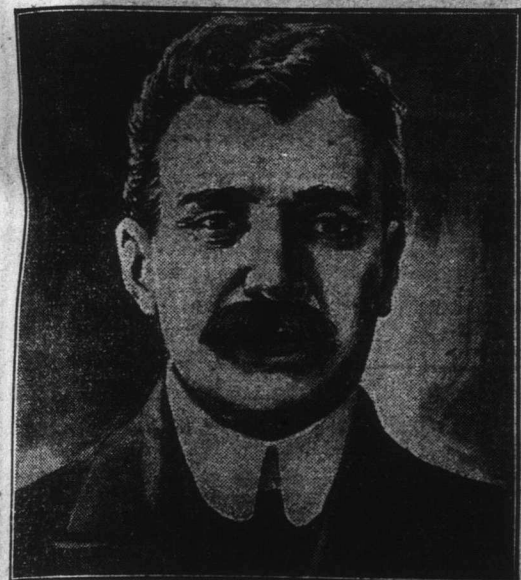

very strong statement to make, but yet I think it is a statement that is wholly warranted by the facts. You will remember that on the first day this Commission met, Mr. Bennett, an attorney, a member of this law society, says, "Now, I wish to take the opportunity of stating in order that it may be as thoroughly calculated as the other report was, that that is entirely unfounded, that Mr. Clarke will be here as a witness, and the reason he isn't here today might be explained from this fact." Then follows the explanation.

Now, the two members of the profession who have been officers of this Commission, were, I think, justified in assuming that a statement solemnly made by counsel to a tribunal such as this was a statement upon which they might with every possible assurance rest, and they have done so. Mr. Minty also gave this tribunal to understand that without question he would be here. He submitted himself to an examination touching a certain matter and his cross-examination was not proceeded with. Mr. Minty has been sworn; he was here as a witness; a subpoena would have captured Mr. Minty and brought him here to this court over since yesterday afternoon. He arrived at Calgary Sunday, went north on Monday, and he was here in this city last night until after nine o'clock. Counsel of this Commission have been placed in an unfair position. Now, if W. R. Clarke is not to be a witness before this tribunal, and Mr. Minty says he is only going to give evidence in the city of Winnipeg, where this court will have no power to compel the giving of evidence, it means that two directors of this railroad are not to be within the courts of this commission. It means that the Commission is to be a laughing stock of a few who live entirely outside of the province.
