CANADA AND GERMANY MAKE UP

After so much beating of the war drum, the German-Canadian trade agreement is a refreshing reminder of the identity of interest among all nations.

The agreement is a victory of peace for this country. Great Britain had bound the self-governing colonies to discriminate in commercial matters against no countries with which she had favored nation treaties. These treaties stood in the way of preferential trade within the Empire.

Germany's export trade with Canada was hard hit. It fell from \$9,750,000 to \$6,250,000 in five years, according to a statement in the Berliner Tageblatt. For some time Germany has been making overtures to Canada, and it looks as though the Franco-Canadian treaty had finally determined the Berlin Government to completely surrender.
