THE EASTERN WAR.

In the conflict between Russia and Turkey much blood has already been shed, and not less than two hundred thousand soldiers have fallen in sieges and in the open field of battle.

The neighboring powers of Europe are looking on the present conflict—not exactly as "unconcerned spectators"—but with a sensitive interest which is every day becoming more deeply intensified.

It has been openly asserted that Germany, inspired by the suggestions of Bismarck, is in secret alliance with Russia as respects its invasion of Turkey.

Come what may, it is consoling to know that Great Britain has nothing to fear from foreign invasion. Her supremacy is all powerful on the sea.

On the land, too, from the battles of Cressy and Agincourt down to the downfall of Subas-topol, military strength has been brilliantly shown, and no European power to-day would like to have a contest with a nation of such renown.
