CHENTU, April 16th, 1893,

MY DEAR MRS. GOODERHAM,—Please accept my thanks for that pretty calendar of the W. M. S.; it is so suggestive. As I began to look through it I felt sorry that I would not find my name, but before I finished I found myself included with the others of our mission here.
