

Heat all the ingredients together except the cream. Warm this in a separate vessel, adding to it the pinch of soda. Put all together just before serving.

TEA CAKES.—One cup of sugar, one teaspoonful of butter, one egg, one half teaspoonful of soda, three fourths of a cup of water, one and one-half cups of flour. POTATO SANDWICHES.—These may be made from any kind of fresh meat, but preferably of beef. Fry slices of beef, rather thinly cut, in butter; they must be gently done, and not too dry. Cover one side of each side lumps, a quarter of an inch in thickness, egg and bread crumbs over then proceed in the same way with the other side. With a sharp knife trim them into pieces of equal size and shape, square or three-cornered. Fry them in hot fat a light brown colour and serve.

CHICKEN PIE.—Parboil a good-sized chicken, after carving it as if to be served; take out of water. Then put in a cupful of milk, to which has been added flour enough to moderately thicken it; salt and pepper. Let this boil gently for a quarter of an hour. Put at bottom and sides of a pie-dish a lining of paste; lay the pieces of chicken in with a quarter of a pound of pork in very thin slices. Fill the dish with the liquor you have ready. You can ornament the paste with strips, but be sure to leave a small aperture in the top of crust. It will be done in fifty minutes in a moderately hot oven.
