Bagdad, March 15, 1935

The Governments of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Canada, the Commonwealth of Australia, New Zealand, the Union of Australia, New Zealand, the Union of Iraq, on the South Africa and India, on the one hand, and the Government of Iraq, on the other hand, being and care of the graves Africa and India, on the one hand, and the Government of Iraq, on the graves of British soldier desirous of placing the permanence and care of the graves interred in Iraqi territory, of British soldiers who fell in the late War and were interred in Iraqi territory, upon a firm and established basis, have agreed as follows:-
