**TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF
CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF COSTA RICA**

The Government of Canada and the Government of Costa Rica, wishing to strengthen the existing cordial relations between the two states and their peoples and moved by the desire to develop a program of technical co-operation between the two countries in conformity with the objectives of economic and social development in Costa Rica, have agreed to the following:

ARTICLE I

The program of technical co-operation will provide for:

- (1) Scholarships, fellowships and training awards for Costa Rican citizens in Canada, or in a third country,
- (2) Canadian experts, instructors, and technicians to work in Costa Rica,
- (3) Such equipment and materials as may be required for the successful execution of projects of technical co-operation in Costa Rica,
- (4) The elaboration of studies, and projects designed to contribute to the social and economic development of Costa Rica,
- (5) Any other form of assistance which may be mutually agreed upon.

ARTICLE II

The Government of Canada agrees to assume all those responsibilities referred to in Annex A to this Agreement, entitled "Responsibilities of the Government of Canada", at the time and in the manner set out.

ARTICLE III

The Government of Costa Rica or its institutions agrees to assume all those responsibilities referred in Annex B of this Agreement, entitled "Responsibilities of the Government of Costa Rica", at the time and in the manner set out. The scope of these responsibilities may be modified in relation to specific projects.

ARTICLE IV

The Government of Canada shall be responsible for all costs incurred under this Agreement, under any amendment hereto, or under subsidiary agreement that are enumerated therein as being the responsibility of the Government of Canada. The Government of Costa Rica shall be responsible for all costs under the present agreement that are not designated as being the responsibility of the Government of Canada.
