

BYE LAWS.

ARTICLE I.

Hour at which business is to begin. **T**HE business of the Society shall be commenced fifteen minutes after the hour of Meeting whatever may be the number of the Members present.

Motions. **ART. 2.** Every motion made in the Society shall be in writing, and seconded by a Member, after which it shall be delivered to the President to be put to the vote, or laid over, as the case may require.
