If she be not in the new and everlasting eovcnant, and she be with another man, she has eommitted adultery; and if her husband be with another woman, and he was under a vow, he hath broken his vow, and hath eommitted adultery; and if she hath not eommitted adultery, but is innocent, and hath not broken her vow, and she knoweth it, and I reveal it unto you, my servant Joseph, then shall you have power, by the power of my holy priesthood, to take her, and give her unto him that hath not committed adultery, but hath been faithful; for he shall be made ruler over many; for I have conferred upon you the keys and power of the priesthood, wherein I restore all things, and make known unto you all things in due time.
