proposition of the United States, the foregoing stipulation in $\mathbf{5}$ favor of Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland, or either 6 of them, will be omitted; but in all other respects the United 7 8 States will give full effect to the plan of union. If Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland, Nova Seotia, and New Bruns-9 wick shall decline the proposition, but Canada, British Co-10 lumbia, and Vancouver island shall, with the eonsent of Great 11 Britain, accept the same, the construction of a railway from 12 Truro to Riviere du Loup, with all stipulations relating to the 13maritime provinces, will form no part of the proposed plan 14 of union, but the same will be consummated in all other 15respects. If Canada shall deeline the proposition, then the 16stipulations in regard to the Saint Lawrence canals and a rail-17 way from Ottawa to Sault Ste. Marie, with the Canadian 18 19 elause of debt and revenue indemnity, will be relinquished. If the plan of union shall only be accepted in regard to the 20northwestern territory and the Paeifie provinces, the United 2122States will aid the construction, on the terms named, of a railway from the western extremity of Lake Superior, in the 23State of Minnesota, by way of Pembina, Fort Garry, and the $\mathbf{24}$ valley of the Saskatehewan, to the Paeifie eoast, north of 25latitude forty-nine degrees, besides securing all the rights and 26privileges of an American territory to the proposed Terri-27tories of Selkirk, Saskatchewan, and Columbia. 28
