Indian Shipments.

India-Broomhall estimates the shipments from Kutch and other districts, against 1,000,000 bushels last week, and 800,000 bushels last year.

World's Estimates.

Broomhall estimates wheat and flour shipments for the week (excluding India) at 6,000,000 bushels, against 7,500,000 bushels last week. Of this total, Europe will take about 5,000,000 bushels, the total shipments last week were 5,485,000 bushels, and last year 10,350,000 bushels. Arrivals of breadstuffs into the United Kingdom will be about 1,000,000 bushels. He predicts there will be a fair decrease on passage.
