of the part of the Dominion of Canada, at the next session thereof to incorporate a railway company under the name of the "Cambridge, Lake Ontario & Western Railway Company," to be declared a work for the public advantage of Canada, with power to construct, maintain and operate a railway from a point on the Ontario & Quebec Division of the Canadian Pacific Railway between the stations of Blairton and Hoo, thence in a southwesterly direction through the Counties of Hastings,
