Ottawa 29th November, 1904



Sir,

I am directed to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th October last, Ref. 206070/9, stating that a discharge from Treaty has been granted to John Saunders, No. 114 of John Smith's Band, including his wife, Caroline Saunders, nee Nelson, and their children Albert James, Hans and Annie, and to say that according to the records of the Saskatchewan Half-breed Commission, Mrs. Saunders and her son, Albert James Saunders, received scrip at Prince Albert in 1900; and according to their evidence they stated that they were not members of any Indian Band.
