to be re-introduced at some further meeting. Grand Falls did not ask tax reform of the legislature this year.

Newcastle asked this year and was granted an act by which its poll tax is fixed at \$5 flat instead of having, as formerly, to be reckoned under the general assessment act which calls for the raising of one-sixth of the revenue by poll tax and which made Newcastle's poll tax and which made Newcastle's poll tax by special act is \$3.50, and that of St. John is lower still. Moneton's this year is \$5.26.

No other legislation of any importance in tax reform was obtained from the New Brunswick assembly this year. Campbellton, which asked in 1912 for the right to exempt improvements upon a majority vote of the people, and Moneton, which asked, the same year, for permission to gradually exempt improvements, both requests being refused, will probably make similar demands at the coming session.

In Newcastle council last winter a motion to ask for legislation authorizing gradual exemption of improvements should the people be willing, was defeated by a vote of five to three.


